The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) is a new way of providing care and support for people with disability in Australia.

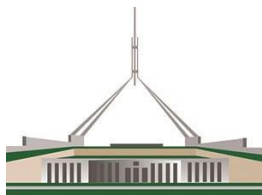


We want to find out if the NDIS is making a difference to older people with disability.
